

Gratitude Along the Tanglefoot

Writing and Art Competition and Virtual Showcase November 4-18, 2020

About the Event

School-age students (Pre-K through 12th grade) in New Albany and Pontotoc County are invited to participate in an autumn gratitude festival in the weeks leading up to the Thanksgiving holiday. This event is organized by M Partner, an initiative of the University of Mississippi that works to improve quality of life in partner communities. New Albany was an M Partner community from 2018-2020, and Ecru and Pontotoc are M Partner communities for the next phase of the program, which will run from 2020-2022.

The *Gratitude Along the Tanglefoot* writing and art competition will ask local students to answer the question *what are you thankful for?* through various mediums. Their writing and art projects will then be judged by a panel of community leaders and M Partner representatives. Selected student work will be uploaded to an online gallery on the McLean Institute Facebook page (@McLeanUM), and selected pieces will be displayed in the business district of each partner community. This festival encourages community participation and collaboration at a safe distance during the COVID-19 pandemic, while simultaneously engaging local students' creativity.

Prompts and Submission Guidelines

Using their preferred medium, students can express their response to the question: *What are you thankful for*? The contest will be announced Wednesday, November 4th and submissions will be accepted until Wednesday, November 18th at 5:00 P.M. Students are limited to one submission: writing or art. Participants are encouraged to register and submit their work online at <u>mclean.olemiss.edu/gratitude</u>.

Participants who wish for their work to be displayed in the windows of local businesses must also drop off their work at one of the following locations: Ecru Town Hall (176 Main Street, Ecru, MS 38841), New Albany Main Street Association (135 East Bankhead Street, New Albany, MS 38652), or Pontotoc City Hall (116 North Main Street, Pontotoc, MS 38863). All participants must complete and enclose a registration form along with their art or writing submission. See the reverse of this page for the entry form to submit at the drop-off locations.

- Art Category: In a sketch, painting, collage, or other art medium, answer the question: *What are you thankful for*?
- Writing Category: In a fiction or nonfiction piece, answer the question: *What are you thankful for?* Fiction and nonfiction pieces must be no longer than 1,000 words, 12-point font, double spaced. (Handwritten responses will be accepted for younger students.)

Participants will be judged by age group and category. The age groups and categories are as follows:
